Lactation Support

Parenting Classes

The goal of our parent education classes is to enable you to start this new phase of your life with confidence and ease. We offer a variety of classes that cover topics such as physical and mental preparation for labor and birth, epidural anesthesia, breastfeeding, newborn care and more. Comprehensive Pediatric Network

At *Florida Hospital for Children*, our team of more than 135 highly skilled pediatric specialists delivers extraordinary care across more than 35 pediatric subspecialties, including a children's emergency department, a Level IV pediatric epilepsy center, a world-renowned pediatric heart center, Central Florida's first and only pediatric bone marrow transplant unit and a level 3 neonatal intensive care unit (NICU). Additionally, we place special emphasis on preventive health and wellness programs that provide education, support and services for major pediatric health issues such as obesity and diabetes.

Visit Us

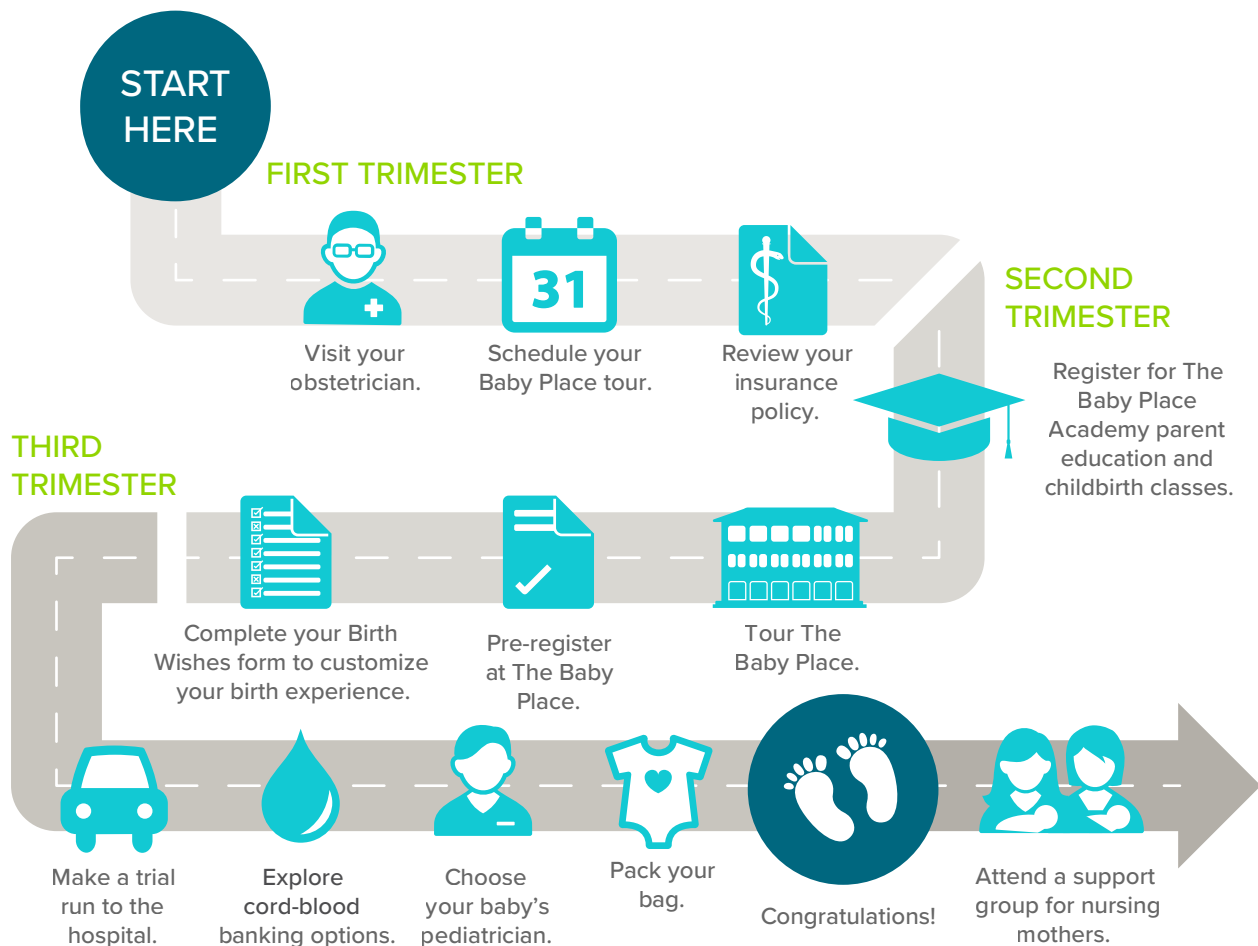
